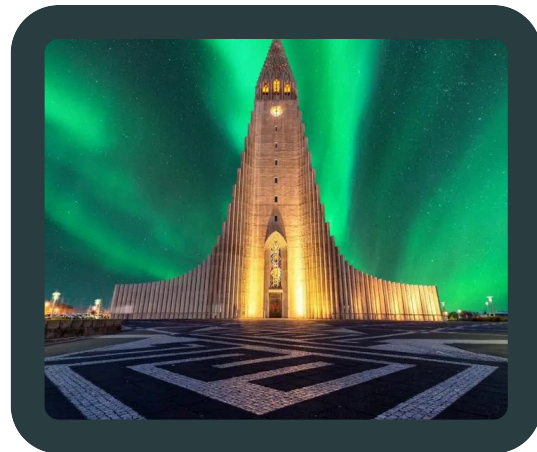
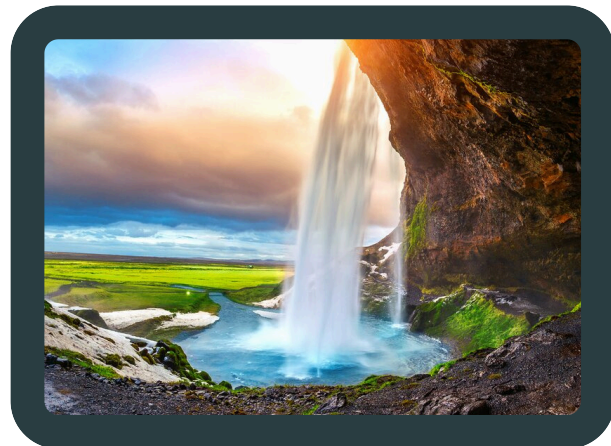

# ICELAND

## A TOP 10 TRAVEL DESTINATION

**The Republic of Iceland, Lýðveldið Ísland in Icelandic, is a Nordic island country in the North Atlantic Ocean. It has a population of 332,529 and an area of 103,000 km<sup>2</sup>, making it the most sparsely populated country in Europe. The capital and largest city is Reykjavík. Reykjavík and the surrounding areas in the southwest of the country are home to over two-thirds of the population. Iceland is volcanically and geologically active. The interior consists of a plateau characterized by sand and lava fields, mountains and glaciers, while many glacial rivers flow to the sea through the lowlands. Iceland is warmed by the Gulf Stream and has a temperate climate, despite a high latitude just outside the Arctic Circle. Its high latitude and marine influence still keeps summers chilly, with most of the archipelago having a tundra climate.**

### Itinerary

**Day 1** – Depart Wilkes-Barre and Scranton to the Newark International Airport to board our Icelandair flight to Reykjavik

**Day 2** – Arrive in Iceland, “Land of the Midnight Sun,” Reykjavik City Tour, Northern Lights Tour. Most flights arrive in the early morning so our rooms will not be ready. This morning, we will enjoy our Guided Reykjavik City Tour, the world’s most northerly capital and where more than one third of Iceland’s population resides. First stop will be the Viking Museum with breakfast. Then we will head straight to the capital and see the city’s major attractions including: Parliament, the National Museum, Laugadalur swimming pool, the Asmundur Sveinsson Sculpture Museum. The Pearl, Holfoi House, Hallgrímskirkja Church, whose steeple is a Reykjavik landmark. Entry to the Wonders of Iceland exhibitions & observation deck at Perlan. Then check in our hotel. Afternoon at leisure. Evening Northern Lights Tour, Aurora Borealis, among the most spectacular phenomena on earth.

**Day 3** – Full day at leisure. Reykjavik is surrounded by incredible landscapes and countless natural wonders. Our optional tour of the Golden Circle showcases some of Iceland’s most popular tourist attractions, including the country’s best known natural, cultural, and historic sites. The Geysir geothermal area, home of the famous Geysir and Strokkur hot springs which erupts every 5 minutes, the Gullfoss waterfall, the queen of Iceland’s waterfalls, tumbling down a deep gorge, and Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site where the tectonic plates of Europe and North America meet and one of the world’s oldest parliaments was founded in 930AD, are all included on this tour.

**Optional: Golden Circle Tour \$160 per person with lunch**

**Day 4**– Full day at leisure to explore Reykjavik at your own pace, to catch up on last minute shopping, or to enjoy some of the local delicacies, including Hakari, fermented shark that is hung out to dry for four months. Choose an optional tour of the world famous Blue Lagoon, a unique geothermal spa situated in the youngest lava field in west Iceland. **Optional: Blue Lagoon experience \$160 per person.**

**Day 5** – Full day at leisure. Explore Reykjavik and enjoy many of its museums, National Museum, Reykjavik Art museum, Whales of Iceland etc. or enjoy a soak in Laugardalur geothermal pool. Explore lovely Old Reykjavik and shop Laugavegur or take a Whale Watching tour at Old Harbor.

**Day 6** – Depart Iceland. Return to Newark International Airport for motorcoach to WilkesBarre/Scranton
