Tue, Sep 23 – DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Wed, Sep 24 – DUBLIN ARRIVAL

After landing at Dublin Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, stop to have breakfast with your group at a local restaurant or pub. Then, drive into Blarney, where you can climb the battlements of Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Continue your travel into Killarney, check into your hotel and settle into your room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a delightful welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DINNER AND OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY

Thu, Sep 25 – RING OF KERRY

This morning, travel to the Gap of Dunloe to visit Moriarty's Gift Shop. Since the shop opened in 1964, Moriarty's has become the landmark destination for shoppers. Following, set off to explore the Ring of Kerry, which consists of over 100 miles of marvelous scenery. See some of Ireland's highest peaks on one side of the road and a coastline scattered with golden beaches and rocky headlands on the other. There will also be plenty of stops to take-in the scenery and to snap photos. Head back to your hotel in Killarney, where the balance of the day is free for individual pursuits and dining.

OVERNIGHT: KILLARNEY PLAZA HOTEL, KILLARNEY

Fri, Sep 26 – CLIFFS OF MOHER

Leaving Killarney, travel into Tarbert and take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. Next, drive along the coast of scenic County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most beloved, natural landmarks. See magical vistas, overlooking the shimmering Atlantic Ocean along with Ireland's Western coastline. Continue your journey into Limerick, check into your hotel and enjoy some free time before a festive evening with your group.

Tonight, head into Durty Nelly's Pub, which stands in the shadow of Bunratte Castle and has been in business for about two centuries. It is a warren of small rooms and intimate bars with cozy fireplace seats. There is usually a lively "session" of music and the atmosphere is spirited. While there, enjoy an authentic Irish dinner with your group.

OVERNIGHT: LIMERICK STRAND HOTEL, LIMERICK

Sat, Sep 27 – SEAN'S BAR

Departing Limerick, drive into Athlone and stop at Sean's bar, Ireland's oldest Pub, to enjoy a drink with your fellow travelers. Then, journey into Kilbeggan and stop to visit the Kilbeggan Distillery, which was established in 1757 and is one of the oldest licensed distilleries in the world. While here, enjoy a tour and tasting of the finished product. Transfer to your hotel in Dublin, check in and settle into your room. This evening, you might like to sample the fine local cuisine by dining at a nearby venue.

OVERNIGHT: ROYAL MARINE HOTEL, DUBLIN

Sun, Sep 28 – FOOTBALL GAME

Spend the morning and afternoon free to relax and sightsee and explore Dublin. There are plenty of shops along Nassau Street and the pedestrianized Grafton Street or Henry Street. You may like to explore Temple Bar or visit some of the traditional pubs. Later in the day, you might like to dine in one of the traditional or modern dinner venues located within the city.

After an independent dinner, head to Croke Park, Ireland's largest stadium and headquarters of the Gaelic Athletic Association. The Pittsburgh Steelers will play at the Famous Croke Park. TICKETS INCLUDED!

Mon, Sep 29 – DUBLIN SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, set off on an orientation drive around Dublin city center. See the main thoroughfares of O'Connell Street, Nassau Street and some lovely public parks as you pass by many historical sites. Stop to tour Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. Head back to your nearby hotel, where you might like to relax or freshen up before tonight's farewell festivities.

In the evening, head to Taylors Three Rock for quality Irish food that is accompanied with lively music and dance.
