### Day 1

Wednesday, September 24

Departing Flight from USA to Munich

### Day 2

Thursday, September 25

Morning arrival in Munich, Capital of Bavaria and Germany's third largest city founded by Monks in 1158, has evolved into a world class metropolis for good taste and it's own enchanting ambiance. The Wittelsbach Dynasty ruled the onetime Kingdom of Bavaria for more than 800 years, leaving it's mark in art and culture, rich in testimony to the Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque and Rococo past. Meet your tour manager and transfer with your deluxe motor coach for a leisurely drive by way of Lake Tegernsee and Lake Achensee to Innsbruck and hotel check-in. Afterwards continue to Innsbruck and hotel check-in. Dinner in your hotel. (D)

### Day 3

Friday, September 26

Morning guided city tour of Innsbruck dating back to the 12th century includes the Golden Dacherl built in 1420 by Emperor Maximilian I, the city Tower built in 1440 featuring a 16th century bulbous cupola and the Old Town. Afternoon excursion over the breathtaking 5,000ft. Brenner Pass into Alto Adige region of northern Italy to the medieval cobblestone village of Vipiteno, noted for its excellent buys in leather goods, silk, Italian fashion and naturally some of the region's finest wines. Returning late afternoon to your hotel and dinner in local restaurant (BD)

### Day 4

Saturday, September 27

08:00 am – Departure west to Garmisch-Partenkirchen – in Germany – through picturesque countryside to Fussen and Neuschwanstein Castle, one of King Ludwig II most extraordinary fantasies – by scheduled coach up and down to Castle – Guided visit – Return to Innsbruck in the afternoon – Dinner on your own (B)

### Day 5

Sunday, September 28

Morning at leisure in Innsbruck for individual activities – shopping, sightseeing ! NOON: mountain excursion by funicular from Innsbruck downtown to the Hungerburg plateau. Continue by cable car to the top of the mountain – summit of the 7,728 ft. Hafelekar Mountain with a superb view over Innsbruck and the Inn Valley. 05:45 pm – Depart for Special "Farmhouse style dinner" in nearby Sistrans at Gasthof Glungezer with entertainment by local folklore group (BD)

### Day 6

Monday, September 29

Full day tour of Salzburg, the delightful and elegant city of music known throughout the world as the birthplace of none other than Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. A city of wide open plazas, narrow medieval lanes dominated by the magnificent fortress of Hohensalzburg, the remarkable Residence, the Old Town, Haus of Mozart and other exciting highlights. Remainder of day at leisure to shop along the Getreidegasse, treat yourself to a Fialer ride (horse carriages) and some sinful Salzburger pastries. Returning late afternoon to Innsbruck. Dinner on your own. (B)

Tuesday, September 30

Morning transfer to Bavaria – visit Ettal Monastery and Castle Linderhof After lunch break arrive at your Munich hotel in the afternoon. Enjoy browsing on Oktoberfest ground. Dinner on your own (B)

Wednesday, October 1

Morning guided city walking tour including the "performing" Glockenspiel (carrillon) at the historic Marienplatz. Afternoon at leisure on OKTOBERFEST ground! Farewell dinner at AUGUSTINER Celler (BD)
