Cliffs of Moher

See magical vistas, overlooking the shimmering Atlantic Ocean along with Ireland's Western coastline. Following, journey into Bunratty and stop at Durty Nelly's Pub, which stands in the shadow of Bunratty Castle and has been in business for about two centuries. It is a warren of small rooms and intimate bars with cozy fireplace seats. There is usually a lively 'session' of music and the atmosphere is spirited. While here, enjoy one pint of beer, wine or soft drink per person. Return to your hotel in Killarney in time to dine with your group in the hotel restaurant.
