Day 1 Tuesday, September 15

Day 2 Wednesday, September 16

Welcome to Munich, the capital of Bavaria and Germany's third-largest city. Founded by monks in 1158, Munich has grown into a world-class metropolis known for its refined taste and unique charm. The city's rich cultural heritage is deeply influenced by the Wittelsbach Dynasty, which ruled the former Kingdom of Bavaria for over 800 years. Their legacy lives on in the city's stunning architecture and art, showcasing Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Rococo styles. Meet your tour manager and board your deluxe motor coach for a scenic drive through the picturesque landscapes of Lake Tegernsee and Lake Achensee. Continue to Innsbruck, nestled in the heart of the Alps, and check in to your hotel. Enjoy a relaxing dinner at your hotel. (B, D)

Day 3 Thursday, September 17

Explore Innsbruck, a city with roots dating to the 12th century. Highlights include the iconic **Golden Roof (Goldenes Dachl)**, built in 1420 by Emperor Maximilian I, and the **City Tower**, constructed in 1440 and crowned with a distinctive 16th-century bulbous cupola. Wander through the charming **Old Town**, rich in medieval architecture and alpine ambiance. Travel over the breathtaking **Brenner Pass**, soaring to 5,000 feet, into the scenic Alto Adige region of northern Italy. Discover the medieval cobblestone village of **Vipiteno**, renowned for its excellent shopping—leather goods, silk, Italian fashion—and some of the region's finest wines. Return to your hotel in Innsbruck and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 4 Friday, September 18

Departure to **Garmisch-Partenkirchen** and begin your day with a scenic journey west through the picturesque Bavarian countryside, passing through **Füssen** and the legendary **Neuschwanstein Castle**—one of King Ludwig II's most extraordinary creations. Enjoy a scheduled coach ride up and down the castle hill, followed by a guided tour of this fairytale masterpiece. Return to Innsbruck in the afternoon, with time to relax or explore at your leisure. Dinner on your own—take the opportunity to discover local cuisine at one of Innsbruck's charming restaurants. (B)

Day 5 Saturday, September 19

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Innsbruck with time for individual activities—whether it's shopping, sightseeing, or simply soaking in the alpine charm. At noon, embark on a mountain excursion departing from downtown Innsbruck aboard the **funicular** to the **Hungerburg Plateau**, then continue by cable car to the summit of **Hafelekar Mountain**, reaching an elevation of 7,728 feet. Take in breathtaking panoramic views over Innsbruck and the Inn Valley. In the evening, depart for a special "**Farmhouse Style Dinner**" in nearby Sistrans at **Gasthof Glungezer**, featuring lively entertainment by a local folklore group. (B, D)

Day 6 Sunday, September 20

Enjoy a relaxing day exploring Innsbruck at your own pace! Optional: For those looking to venture further, we suggest a **scenic day trip to Salzburg**—the birthplace of Mozart and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Frequent trains run throughout the day, with a comfortable **2-hour journey each way** or Trip to Dachau Concentration Camp. (B)

Day 7 Monday, September 21

Begin the day with a scenic transfer into **Bavaria**. Visit the impressive **Ettal Monastery**, where you'll enjoy a **guided tour of the historic brewery**, complete with a **beer tasting experience**. Continue to the charming village of **Oberammergau**, world-famous for its **Passion Play**, performed every ten years. Enjoy leisure time for lunch and shopping. Arrive at your hotel in Munich in the afternoon and prepare to celebrate Bavarian culture at the world-renowned **Munich Oktoberfest**—a festive evening filled with music, food, and traditional fun! (B)

Day 8 Tuesday, September 22

Start your day with a guided walking tour through Munich's historic center, including a visit to **Marienplatz** to witness the famous **Glockenspiel (carillon)** performance—a delightful display of Bavarian tradition. Spend the afternoon soaking in the festive atmosphere of the **Oktoberfest grounds**. Visit the **amusement park**, sip local wines at the **wine bars**, and experience the lively energy of the **iconic beer tents**. Enjoy the celebration until **5:00 PM**. Gather for a memorable **farewell dinner** at the traditional **Augustiner Keller**, one of Munich's most beloved beer halls. (B, D)
