DAY 1 – OCTOBER 8

NEWARK to CALGARY

- Transfers to Newark from Wilkes-Barre/Scranton.
- Transfers to Delta Calgary Downtown Hotel.
- Arrive in Calgary and spend the remainder of the day on your own to explore. Affectionately known as "Cowtown," Calgary exudes a youthful vitality as well as frontier spirit. Just east of the Rockies, it's a dynamic city with an ever-changing list of attractions.

DAY 2 – OCTOBER 9

CALGARY TO BANFF

- Elk + Avenue Hotel. Enjoy a motorcoach tour exploring the many places of interest around Banff, including Banff Gondola, Bow Falls, Surprise Corner, and the Hoodoos. (B)

DAY 3 – OCTOBER 10

BANFF

- Elk + Avenue Hotel. Enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour and learn about the natural forces that have shaped the appearance of the lakes and streams found in this area of the Rocky Mountains. Highlights include Lake Louise, Yoho National Park, the Spiral Tunnels, Emerald Lake, Natural Bridge and Takakkaw Falls. Lunch today is included. (B, L)

DAY 4 – OCTOBER 11

BANFF TO KAMLOOPS

- **Goldleaf.** Overnight stay in contemporary Kamloops Hotel accommodations. Travel onboard Rocky Mountaineer from the mountain town of Banff to Kamloops, in the heart of the BC Interior. Enjoy the spectacular array of scenery as you travel between the glacier and snow-capped peaks of the Canadian Rockies, over mountain passes and through remarkable tunnels, along rocky lakeshores and across the ranchlands of the Interior. Today's highlights include the Continental Divide, the Spiral Tunnels, Kicking Horse Canyon, Rogers Pass, and Craigellachie, where the last spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway was driven.
